# Announcements / New Initiatives *The Netherlands*

- **Funding: €783.5 mln (859 mln USD) will be awarded to 7 large-scale electrolyser projects with a combined capacity of almost 1.2 GW. FID in 2023.**
- **New funding for h2 vehicles/infrastructure and small-scale production projects (including “hydrogen turbines”).**
- **Infrastructure: H2 backbone construction to start this year (new pipelines + repurposing existing grid)**
- **Announcement of 500 MW offshore h2 production project, combined with expansion of offshore wind**
- **International supply chains: new international collaborations including Australia and Spain, more to follow. H2Global participation with 300 million euro.**
- **Announcements for 10-15 import terminals: ammonia, LOHC and LH2**
- **Government to develop vision on hydrogen carriers (in particular safety and spatial aspects)**
- **Operational pilots with h2 in built environment**
- **World Hydrogen Summit 9-11 May in Rotterdam**
