



**‘Hydrogen Roadmap Korea’, announced on Jan. 17, 2019, finally hits all cylinders by bringing extensive cooperation between related government ministries, local governments, and public-private partnership to meet the National Targets.**

- **HyNet, a special purpose company initiated by public-private partnership (H2KOREA), responded in March by announcing its plan to jump into hydrogen infrastructure investment including the installation of 100 HRS’s by 2022.**
- **Six government ministries are participating to set up R&D roadmap which will spend approximately 2 trillion KRW for the next 10 years.**
- **Parliament is working to pass so-called ‘Hydrogen Economy Law’ by June this year, which is expected to cover all aspects in hydrogen economy from R&D to deployment to market transformation.**
