## Policy

- Assessment of policy instruments for h2 in the NL (October '23, file (overheid.nl))
- Opening tender for projects up to 50 MW (250 million euro) in December '23
- Evaluating 2030 targets of 3-4 GW
- Research on impact of various h2 carriers

## <u>Projects</u>

- EU (IPCEI) approval for funding LOHC terminal in Rotterdam
- New projects including Eneco / Mitsubishi: 800 MW in Rotterdam (construction '26)
- FID on two "blue h2 projects" CCS for existing hydrogen production in Rotterdam International
- Launch and expansion of the International Hydrogen Trade Forum
- Strengthening efforts for creating import-export corridors including LH2
- MoU with Germany on H2Global shared tender planned for end of 2024
