### **IPCEI (Important Project of Common European Interest) strategic funding projects**

- 8 Austrian companies in 2 focus areas ("H2 Industry" and "H2 Technology) participate
- 2<sup>nd</sup> informal request (European Commission) for information has finished, a 3<sup>rd</sup> round is expected

#### **ERA-pilot Green Hydrogen Agenda Process**

- Strategic Research and Innovation Agenda (SRIA) was presented on 18 March
- Conference on 16/17 May in Berlin, Germany, in order to plan joint activities





**Hydrogen Cluster Austria:** Hydrogen Austria was launched by the Federal Ministry for Digital and Economic Affairs and the province of Tyrol on April 12 in order to bundle the Austrian hydrogen activities and increase visibility

#### "ENIN" Funding program (Zero Emission Commercial Vehicles and Infrastructure):

- Dotation: 275 million €
- 80% of the additional investment costs for the acquisition of zero-emission commercial vehicles will be funded
- 40% of the acquisition costs for charging and hydrogen refuelling infrastructure will be funded
- In 2022 2 tenders are planned (stating in summer 2022). It is expected that two to three tenders per year will follow in 2023, 2024 and 2025. https://www.ffg.at/enin-faq
